- If Division Bench-II is not available, then urgent fixed date cases of "List-1" only shall be listed before the Division Bench-I and such other cases of that Bench, which are directed by Division Bench-I shall also be listed.
- In case, Division Bench-I cannot hear the matters because of any other reason, then the matters shall be listed before Division Bench-II and viceversa.
- If any case pertains to Division Bench and is exception to the Division Bench-I & II, then it shall be listed before Special Commercial Division Bench comprising Hon'ble Mr. Justice Manindra Mohan Shrivastava and Hon'ble Mr. Justice Goutam Bhaduri, whenever it is constituted and is not exception to this Bench.
