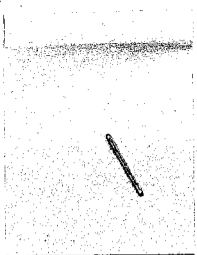

Annexure-I
Terms & Conditions

1. The invited tender could be cancelled by the competent authority of this High Court at any time without showing any reason.
2. Time limit for tender :- 45 days from the date *20.11.2017*
3. Tender shall be sent on the address mentioned below by registered post (AD) :-

OR

shall be put into the prescribed tender box.

4. The tenders must be submitted till 3 p.m. during the office hours of the prescribed last date published in the news paper.
5. The tender may be opened one hour after prescribed time on the last date of receiving tender.
6. The tender shall be submitted in two envelopes :-
One envelop should contain security deposit or certificate regarding exemption thereof and in second envelop tender documents, and should be written on the envelopes accordingly. Envelope containing security deposit shall be opened first and if found proper or having exemption certificate, then second envelope containing tender document shall be opened, otherwise it can be rejected.
7. Tenders which are received after the prescribed time and date, shall not be opened and shall be returned. Returning time and date shall be written on the sealed envelop.
8. Security deposit amount would be 3% of the estimated purchase value of Rs. 3,62,00,000/-. The security deposit amount shall be

deposited in this office through demand draft made in the name of “Registrar General, High Court of Chhattisgarh, Bilaspur (C.G.)” only. The security deposit amount of the qualifying tenderer shall retain and rest security deposit amount shall be returned within 15 days to tenderes (except the qualifying tenderer). The amount of security deposit may be returned to the qualifying tenderer under the following modes :-

1.	After 01 year from the date of completion of satisfactory supply/ installation of the articles.	20% of the security amount
2.	After 02 years.	30% of the security amount
3.	After 03 years.	500% of the security amount

9. The interested firm must be registered with the Commercial Tax Department. For this photocopy of the certificate of registration (in force) with the Commercial Tax Department should be enclosed with the tender. Income Tax clearance certificate must be submitted with the tender.
10. The tenderer shall mention the addresses of the business organization from where the goods will be supplied to this High Court.
11. The tenderer can demonstrate his product.
12. The competent authority or authorized officer of this High Court may inspect the goods at the time of manufacturing thereof.
13. The tenderer or his authorized representative may present at the time of opening of tenders.
