

Configure IMAP for iPhone or iPad

The iPhone and iPad supports IMAP. Following are the steps to configure device for IMAP.

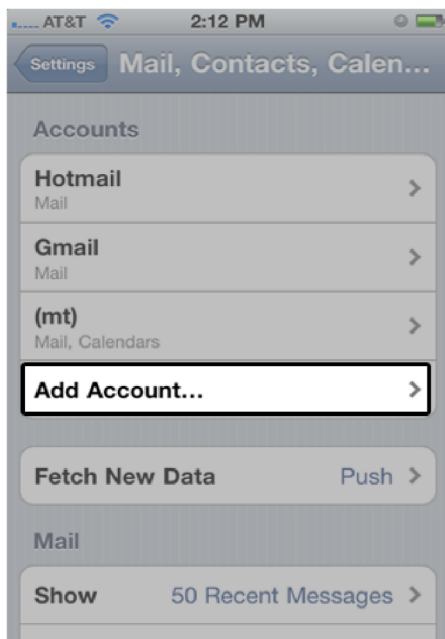
1. From the Home screen, choose Settings.



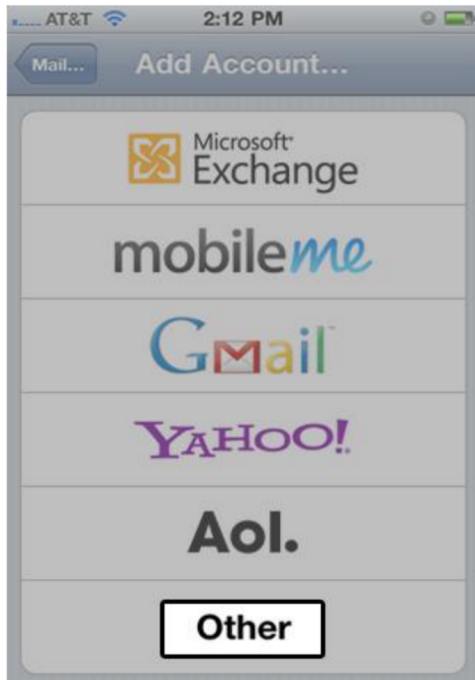
2. Next, tap Mail, Contacts, Calendars.



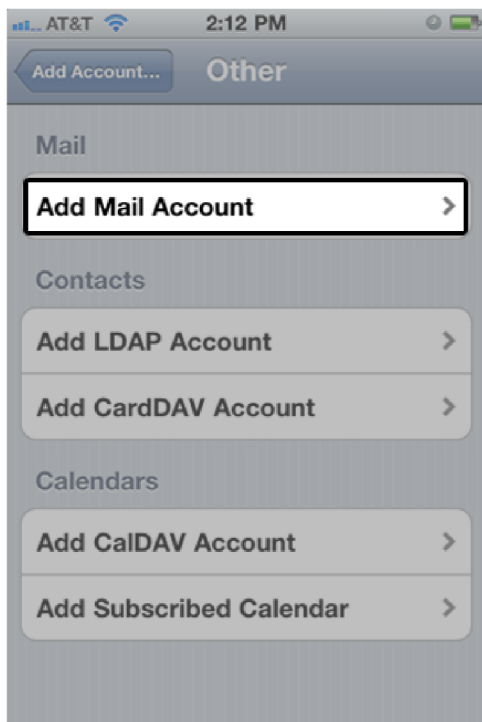
3. In the Accounts section, tap Add Account....
