Part-A

As per approved scheme for utilization of fund granted by the 13th finance commission, a legal database with Linux (Red Hat Enterprises Linux-5 & Ubuntu) compatible searching software is proposed to be purchased for all Judicial Officers of State of C.G. (400 approx). Hence sealed proposal in format prescribed in Part-B are invited from interested reputed firms for purchasing, supply, installation and training of required legal data base with no renewal charges or expenses during award period of 13th finance commission scheme.

As per our basic requirement the database must contain at least following items:-

- 1. Maximum coverage of all Judgments of Privy Council (1870-1950)
- 2. Having all the Judgments and Orders of Supreme Court since 1950 till current year giving maximum coverage.
- 3. Having all Judgments of all High Courts from the date of their establishment with special coverage given to M.P. High Court and Chhattisgarh High Court giving maximum coverage.
- 4. Having all Judgments of Nagpur High Court till separation of M.P. High Court giving maximum coverage.
- 5. All Central Acts and Rules with hyper linking to the Judgments in the software and vice versa.
- 6. All State Acts and Rules with hyper linking to the Judgments in the software and vice versa.
- 7. A Legal Dictionary.
- 8. Alongwith Subscription of online Journal of the Agency quoting for the software for the current year and up to 2015.

 Note-
 - Maximum converge should be given to all the Law Journal Reporting in India.

- Judgments in the software should show the report/citation of all the Journals in which it has been published.
- There should be a special tool to show Judgments overruled and the Judgments that are good case law till now and their reliance made in latter judgments by the Courts should be clearly mentioned and indicated in the software.
- The Data Base should be installed in each Lap Top computer of the Judicial Officers and also be provided on a CD for recovery if required.

Method of receiving proposal -

Proposal should be submitted in two envelopes:-

- I. (1) One envelope should contain security deposit or certificate regarding exemption there of (Only small scale Industries Registered with Chhattisgarh State Industries Department * having exemption certificate refer 4.7 C.G. store purchase rules 2002).
 - (2) Security deposit shall be 3% of the estimated cost of proposal, which may be deposited by challan, in the government treasury or sub treasury or branch of a bank where the government cash transaction are done under the head: "8443 Civil deposit sum 103 Security deposit". The original receipt of a challan should be enclosed with the proposal form.
 - (3) If the firm wants, it can deposit by a Demand Draft of the State Bank of India or Nationalized Bank.
- II. Second envelope shall contain format prescribed in Part- B and alongwith sealed envelope containing the title "PROPOSAL FOR SUPPLY OF LEGAL DATA BASE" and address of the Registrar General, C.G. High Court, Bilaspur at Bodri 495220 and will be submitted to the Registrar General High Court of Chhattisgarh, Bilaspur at Bodri, Pin-495220 by Registered Speed Post, so that it must be received till **3.00 PM of 15/03/2013.**
- III. The proposals will be opened <u>at 4:00 p.m. of 15/03/2013</u>. Proposals which are received after the prescribed time and date will not be opened and same may be returned to the firm concerned.
- IV. Firstly, 1st envelope shall be opened, if the demand draft or original challan of security deposit or the certificate regarding exemption from security deposit is not found in said envelope, the 2nd envelope shall not be opened otherwise it should be rejected.
- V. The firm or their representative may remain present at the time of opening of proposals.

- i. The firm applying should possess valid Income Tax, PAN No., Registration with the Commercial Tax department and Service Tax Account No. The Firms should have minimum experience of 03 years working in the same field.
- ii. Copies of the following documents may be submitted along with the proposal:
 - a. Audit Profit & Loss Account of last three years i.e. 2009-2010, 2010-2011 and 2011-2012. *(optional)*
 - b. Service Tax Certificate.
 - c. Income Tax PAN No.
 - d. Income Tax Return for the last three years i.e. 2009-2010, 2010-2011 and 2011-2012. *(optional)*
 - e. Photocopy of the certificate of the Registration (in force) with the Commercial Tax department.
 - f. ISO Certification. (Optional)
 - g. Latest Service Tax Return.
 - h. Documents regarding Experience of 03 years in providing similar services.
- 2. All proposals shall be addressed to the Registrar General, C.G. High Court, Bilaspur.
- 3. The software has to be installed on all Laptop/Desktop computers of Judicial Officers of the State at their Office/ Residences by the firm concerned within 45 days from the date of issue of Purchase Order.
- 4. The firm concerned shall be responsible for training of the Judicial Officers for using the software within the same period at their headquarters without any extra expenses.
- 5. Firm shall be responsible for providing periodically and annual updates without any cost for the period starting from issue of purchase to 31^{st} March 2015.
- 6. No renewal charges or other expenses shall be payable till 31.03.2015.
- 7. The Hon'ble Purchase Committee shall examine the quality and functionality of software for its final approval. The Committee may call short listed firms for demonstration of their software for satisfaction about quality and functionality of software's.
- 8. Payment Terms: 90% of the payment shall be released on successful and satisfactory installation & training of software. The balance 10% payment shall be released after successful completion.
